COMPOSITION

Each tablet contains:

Nomegestrol Acetate 2.50 mg. + Estradiol (as Hemihydrate) 1.50 mg.

DRUG ACTION

Oral contraceptive.

Regulates the menstrual cycles.

First monophasic oral contraceptive that combines 17beta-Estradiol, which is identical to the endogenous estrogen that the female body naturally produces, and Nomegestrol Acetate, a gestagen derived from natural progesterone. This combination may prevent the adverse effects associated with the synthetic estrogen (Ethinyl Estradiol) and testosterone-derived gestagens present in currently available oral contraceptive combinations. MIRANDA offers the most safety and its metabolic impact was shown to be minimal.

DOSAGE

Take one tablet of MIRANDA on a daily basis for 28 consecutive days. Each package starts with 24 white active tablets, followed by 4 red placebo tablets. Start a new package immediately after finishing the previous one. Similarly to other contraceptives, start the treatment on the first day of the cycle (first day of menstrual bleeding).

PRESENTATION

Each package contains 24 white tablets and 4 red tablets.
